

## **Rules and Regulations**

By entering the park you agree to abide by the following rules and regulations, failure to comply with will mean that you could be excluded from the Park and be subject to further action including prosecution. These rules apply to the Park unless otherwise stated.

## **Definitions**

"Park" refers to Pembrey Country Park, Pembrey Carmarthenshire SA16 0EJ

"Council" means Carmarthenshire County Council

Access to Pembrey Country Park and Beach is permitted only during advertised opening and closing times last entry one hour before closing, we reserve the right to refuse access or amend access times without notice.

Anti-social or inappropriate behaviour towards visitors or our employees will not be tolerated

- Parking charges apply as displayed on the tariff board at the entrance to the country park
- **Bicycles must** be ridden in a safe manner
- > Ebikes- self propelled
- Escooters, hover boards, are not permitted
- All electric motorised off-road capable vehicles are not permitted
- Road legal motorcycles, quad bikes and tricycles must only be driven and parked in approved areas
- > Speed Limits as displayed, must be obeyed at all times

Motorcycles, quad bikes, and all other off road type vehicles are prohibited from using any part of the park which is not intended to be accessible to ordinary motor vehicles

The above does not apply to the emergency services or officers of the Council.

**Dogs and animals must** be under the full control at all times and must not cause disturbance to any person or animal.

**Dogs are NOT permitted in children's playgrounds.** Please note summer byelaws are in effect for Cefn Sidan between May 1<sup>st</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>

Dog Waste- Dog owners must ensure that all dog faeces are removed

**Overnight stays are** not permitted in the park, beach, or dunes. Camping is only allowed at the official campsite or as part of a rally booking.

**Open Fires** are not permitted in the Park on the beach or dunes.

BBQs are not permitted on the beach or dunes

However, the use of disposable or gas BBQs, are permitted in the Park provided they are 300mm (1ft.) off the ground. Cold and wetted ashes must be disposed in the BBQ bins provided.





- Protection of Animals Birds and Hunting all wildlife is protected by law and must not be disturbed or harmed
- > Trees, Shrubs and Flowers must not be damaged or removed from the park
- ➤ Horses or Horse and carriages are not permitted in the country park. They are not permitted on Cefn Sidan between CE 53 and CE58. Horses are NOT permitted on the dunes
- > Removal of any item no items are to be removed from the park, beach, or dunes
- **Rubbish/Waste** All litter must be recycled , placed in a litter bin, or taken home
- Metal Detecting and digging is not permitted in the park or on the beach and dunes
- **Drones** and unmanned aircraft are not permitted in the park, beach, or dunes
- Public shows and Performance and Events are not permitted without written permission from Carmarthenshire County Council
- Advertising no unauthorised advertising is permitted in the park, beach, or dunes
- Naturism and Nudism is not permitted in the park, beach, or dunes
- Filming (other than for personal use) requires written permission from Carmarthenshire County Council
- > Trading (without licence or lease) is not permitted
- > Smoking including e-cigarettes. Is not permitted in any park buildings, identified no-smoking areas or in children's playgrounds.
- > Self-made Tree Swings and other constructions are not permitted
- Exclusive group use of facilities, (this includes open fields, beach and woodland), must be prearranged with the Country Park. A suitably qualified person over 18 years must supervise any group
- **Erecting signs and Notices** no signs are to be placed in the park
- ➤ Meetings/gatherings no meetings or gatherings are to be held without the written permission of Carmarthenshire County Council
- Facilities and Activities in the event of an event cancellation parking fees will not be refunded
- Supervision all visitors must follow the instructions provided by staff or notices
- Emergencies, Accidents/near misses must be reported to the Outdoor Recreation Service at the visitor centre or email <a href="mailto:infopembrey@carmarthenshire.gov.uk">infopembrey@carmarthenshire.gov.uk</a>

The Council reserves the right to amend, alter, add, or withdraw these rules and regulations without prior notice. For further retails please scan the QR code here.

Penalties: Failure to comply with these rules will mean that you may be asked to leave the Park immediately and may mean that future access is denied. Annual season pass holders, may have their annual pass rescinded. If necessary the Police will be informed, if you cause damage of any kind, you will be required to pay for the damage together with any costs incidental to or associated with the damage including any administration and professional fees including legal costs.
